- Organized under MIC's initiatives in November 2011.
- Restructured in October 2016 and revised rules of procedures.
- Objectives:
 - i) to promote information exchange among MIC, registered certification bodies and industry;
 - ii) to contribute to smooth operation of certification system in information and communication.

- Activities:

- i) Drafting guidelines on certification system;
- ii) Organizing workshops and/or lectures;
- iii) Studying trend of certification systems in the world;
- iv) Market surveillance of radio/terminal equipment; and
- v) Information exchange with related organizations abroad.
